

Hurrell's Guide to a Perfect Lawn

Make sure the seedbed is well prepared.

A stone free/weed free level area is required. Weeds can be best treated before sowing with a 'Roundup/Glyphosate' type chemical spray.

Do not 'skimp' on preparation. Time spent in preparation now will reap you back so much enjoyment over the years that your lawn will be established.

Sow your lawn with high quality seed that conforms to HVS standards i.e. High purity and germination seed. Ensure the species and mixture are ones applicable to the site and usage concerned.

Reseed annually and repair bare areas as soon as they appear.

Mow your lawn regularly. Avoid cutting the lawn too low especially in very dry conditions.

Water your lawn regularly especially in dry conditions.

Feed with Nitrogen rich fertiliser in spring or summer and a more balanced lower Nitrogen fertiliser in autumn.

Rake out moss, old and dying grass during Spring and Autumn

Scatter worm grass with a brush before mowing and remove all the clippings

On heavy soils, Aerate your lawn in spring and again in the summer.

Control any weeds and moss. Do not wait until the lawn is infested. The weeds and moss will strangle and kill your new lawn.

Keep all lawn edges neatly trimmed.
